

# 2011 Minnesota State Double-handed High School Championship

Wayzata Community Sailing Center, Wayzata, MN

June 4-5, 2011

NOTICE OF RACE, Amended May 31, 2011

## 1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the 2009 - 2012 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the Club 420 Class rules except as altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

## 2. BOATS:

Club 420s will be provided by WCSC and LMSS, or, bring your own borrowed Club 420 from a sailing school owned fleet; privately owned boats will not be permitted. Spinnaker and Trapeze shall not be used.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY:

### **Saturday, June 5**

Girls State Championships: A "school team" consists of two girl sailors; teams may also have one substitution. Competing high schools must be located in the state of Minnesota. Schools may enter as many teams as they wish. Teams should be from the same school; mixed teams will be permitted but scored only as the skipper's school. No student below the level of 7th grade shall be eligible to compete.

Boys State Championships: A "school team" consists of two boy sailors; teams may also have one substitution. Competing high schools must be located in the state of Minnesota. Schools may enter as many teams as they wish. Teams should be from the same school; mixed teams will be permitted but scored only as the skipper's school. No student below the level of 7th grade shall be eligible to compete.

### **Sunday, June 6**

Coed State Championships: A "school team" consists of a minimum of four sailors; teams may also have up to two substitutions. Competing high schools must be located in the state of Minnesota. Schools may enter up to three coed teams. Sailors must be from the same school. No student below the level of 7th grade shall be eligible to compete. Students who attend a Middle school on the same campus as a high school or a school that feeds into a high school can sail for that high school.

JV/Club/Open: A "team" consists of two sailors; teams may also have one substitution. Competing team sailors must attend a middle or high school in the state of Minnesota. No student below the level of 7th grade shall be eligible to compete

## 4. REGATTA FORMAT:

### **Saturday, June 5**

Girls State Championship: Each "school team" shall sail the same boat, there will be no rotation. Girls will have a separate start. All races shall count; there will be no throw out. Crew substitution is permitted.

Boys State Championship: Each "school team" shall sail the same boat, there will be no rotation. Boys will have a separate start. All races shall count; there will be no throw out. Crew substitution is permitted.

### **Sunday, June 6**

Coed State Championship: Each "school team" shall field an "A" and "B" fleet team. "A" and "B" division will have a separate start, there will be rotation. All races shall count; there will be no throw out. Crew substitution is permitted.

JV/Club/Open: Each “team” shall sail the same boat, there will be no rotation. Teams will have a separate start. All races shall count; there will be no throw out. Crew substitution is permitted.

#### 4. ENTRY:

**The entry fee is \$25.00 per sailor per day.** Checks should be made payable to the **Wayzata Community Sailing Center.**

The entry deadline is Thursday, June 2, 2011 at 6:00 PM. Entries will be accepted after this deadline provided there are boats available.
