

Competitors should make every effort to rig before the 9:00 AM Skippers' Meeting.

Generally, no race shall start after 3:00 PM. Awards will follow the last race.

SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System will be used. If 5 races are completed there will be one throw out race. If 4 or fewer races are completed there will be no throw outs.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented to the top three finishers in all fleets; participation ribbons to all Green fleet sailors.

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the 2009 - 2012 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the C420 Class Association Rules, the Optimist Class Rules, the Laser Class Rules, Rules of TCYS, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. Sailors need not be members of their respective class associations

RISKS: Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor, or in the case of minors, each competitor's parent or guardian agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
